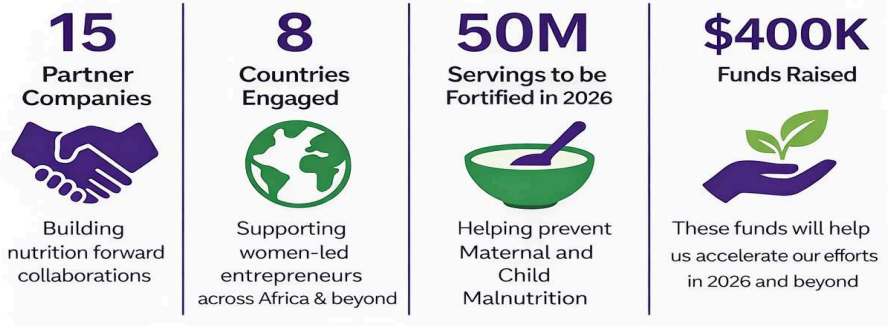


## MOTHERFOOD 2025 PERFORMANCE



2025 was a breakthrough year for MotherFood.

- We significantly expanded our network of partners and women-led entrepreneurs across Africa.
- This year, MotherFood actively supported entrepreneurs in Ghana, Kenya, and Nigeria.
- We laid critical groundwork with best-in-class micronutrient premix partners to ensure the highest-quality fortification for every product.
- Our partners collectively fortified over 2 million servings and we are on track to fortify more than 50 million servings in 2026.

### Entrepreneur Partnerships & Impact

Below is a sample of some of our 2025 projects

[Legendary Foods Africa](#) (Ghana): We deepened our partnership through a financial investment and marketing support to repackage AKO Cookies, leading to over 12 million fortified servings projected in 2026

[Moppet Foods](#) (Nigeria): In partnership with [EHA Impact Ventures](#), we project over 7 million fortified servings of nutritious infant cereal in 2026.

[10X Nutrition](#) (Kenya): With MotherFood's support, over 1 million mandazis were fortified in 2025, with approximately 8 million projected for 2026.

[Plumbee](#) (Kenya): A new partnership expected to exceed 5 million fortified servings of infant cereal in 2026, alongside production efficiency improvements using a Sanku dosifier.

[Sanku](#) (Tanzania & Kenya): Through our partnership supporting two millers, we expect to help fortify approximately 20 million servings in 2026.



## Strategic Nutrition Initiatives

Beyond our core partnerships, MotherFood extends its reach to vulnerable communities through targeted nutritional interventions:



**Northern Quebec:** Provided essential daily vitamins to the entire student population in the village of Imujiaq.

**Nairobi, Kenya:** A 2026 initiative with Ten X Nutrition to provide fortified *mandazi* to every student at the Peace Children Centre.

**Rwanda:** Partnering with Sight and Life to sponsor comprehensive maternal nutritional supplements (MNS) for expectant mothers throughout their pregnancies.
